ClassCharts is coming – what you need to know

From **Tuesday 22 April**, we will begin using a new platform called **ClassCharts** across all our Maiden Erlegh Trust schools.

ClassCharts is a trusted system which we have already successfully trialled at one of our schools. It enables parents and carers to:

- **Report your child's absence**
- **View your child's attendance and behaviour record**
- **See homework that has been set and when it is due**
- **Celebrate your child's progress, including positive points for great work and behaviour**

This means you'll have real-time access to the information that matters most — helping you support your child more easily.

What you need to do to get up and running:

To access ClassCharts, please:

1. **Download the free ClassCharts Parent App** using the QR codes or links below
2. **Log in using your personal access code**, which we will provide towards the end of the Easter Holidays via email
3. **Get in touch** if you need support
